


# STACKAMALS PIG



## instructions

### What's included...

- 58 laser cut pieces
- (Pieces 34 and 35 are connected with glued-in magnets and slide apart)
- Children's PVA glue and glue dabbers
- 15 dowels (shown full size below)
- A bag with extra glue and **spare** small parts

21mm- 4 pieces



6mm- 2 pieces



27mm- 1 piece



15mm- 4 pieces



104mm- 4 pieces



### Before you start, please read through the whole leaflet.

- 2) Use the glue **sparingly** so that it doesn't squeeze out between the layers. If it does, wipe it away with a damp cloth as you work. One glue pot should be enough.
- 3) Push down each layer firmly to ensure they are properly stuck together.
- 4) Follow instructions carefully when placing layers 34 and 35 so the magnets stick to each other when the top and bottom pig halves come together.
- 5) We recommend you test build the pig by building up with **NO GLUE** and **NO DOWELS**.

### Warnings

- Stackamals contain small parts that could be dangerous for children under the age of 3.
- PVA glue is washable only before it dries.
- If small magnets come loose they should be securely glued back in place or disposed of safely.
- Small magnets are dangerous if swallowed.
- Keep magnets away from magnetically sensitive items such as pace makers, credit cards and magnetically stored media.
- Please store this leaflet in a safe place.






#### Part 2 - LID


#### TAKE EXTRA CARE HERE!

Place magnet piece 35 **with writing face down** and glue in the four 15mm dowels with a tiny dab of glue.


Glue pieces 36 to 39 in turn using a small dab of glue near each dowel. **Numbers 36 to 39 should be face up.**




For layer 40 you can choose either a piggy bank slot or a closed piece. Select **either** the slotted **or** closed top piece for layer 40 and glue it centrally **with writing face down**. Wipe away any excess glue.



Using the **six sided** hole in piece E1, glue it onto the dowel near E. **Keep the writing facing the same way.** Repeat for F1 onto F.





Glue the 6mm dowels into the **round** holes in E1 & F1 with a tiny dab of glue. Wipe away any excess glue.



Glue piece E2 onto E1 and piece F2 onto F1.

Glue piece E3 onto E2 and piece F3 onto F2 **but with writing face down.**




Check that the ears look like the drawing above before allowing them to dry for about 30 minutes.


Congratulations, you have now finished building your pig.

# PART 1 - BASE. Start here please...


Find pieces 1a, 1b, 1c and 1d and lay out as shown below with the writing face up and reading the same way up.




Add the 21mm dowels to the inner holes with a tiny dab of glue.




Then glue the long 104mm dowels into the outer holes.




Put a small dab of glue on piece 1a and glue piece 2a to it. Repeat for pieces 2b, 2c and 2d.




Repeat for pieces 3a, 3b, 3c and 3d. Wipe away excess glue each time.




Glue each foot to piece 4, lining up piece 3a under 'a' on layer 4 etc.




Glue on piece 5 with small dabs of glue near the dowels.




Repeat for piece 6. Keep the numbers face up and at the front.




Repeat for piece 7 which has a hole in the middle. Wipe away excess glue as you build.




Continue to glue pieces 8 to 26 in turn. Keep the numbers face up and at the front. Push each layer down firmly and keep wiping away excess glue.




Glue piece 27 in place and add the 27mm dowel with a tiny dab of glue.



Glue pieces 28 to 33 in turn.




**TAKE CARE HERE!** Slide apart magnet pieces 34 and 35 and glue magnet piece 34 in place **with the number FACE DOWN.**



Tail pieces: **With writing face down,** glue piece T1 onto the end of the 27mm dowel and then glue piece T2 onto piece T1.



Wipe away excess glue and place something heavy on the lower half of the pig to press the layers together as they dry (takes about 30 minutes).



Turn over for PART 2 - LID
